Clinical Grades are based on the clinical evaluations following each rotation and the number of competencies completed during that phase.

50% based on the average score of the clinical evaluations

A = 4.1 – 5.0

B = 3.6 – 4.0

C = 3.0 – 3.5

F < 3.0

- 5.0 Distinguished
Student demonstrates comprehensive knowledge of concepts beyond basic requirements.
Student works rapidly and skillfully with precision.
- 4.0 Above Average
Students demonstrates comprehensive knowledge of basic concepts.
Student performs tasks with precision and in the appropriate time frame.
- 3.0 Average
Student demonstrates limited comprehensive knowledge.
Student is hesitant and lacks confidence.
- 2.0 Below Average
Students demonstrates inadequate knowledge of basic concepts.
Student is not attentive to detail.
- 1.0 Unsatisfactory
Student is careless and does not demonstrate skills necessary.

50% based on the total # of completed competency evaluations

A = 85 -100%

B = 75 – 85%

C = 65 – 75%

F < 65%
